2 DONT FORGET AFTER BOARDING!

- Rockin' Bar D, Deck 3 Forward For anyone wishing to book Palo reservations or change their dining rotation don't forget to stop by Rockin' Bar D after you board. Your table number and dining rotation can be found at the bottom of your "Key to the World" room key.
- Shore Excursion Desk, Deck 3 Mid Ship For anyone who has yet to book excursions or could not get excursions booked online, reservations can be made at the desk once you first board.
- Guest Services Desk, Deck 3 Mid Ship Here you can book a number of onboard activities including:
 - Alcohol Tastings
 - Tea with a character for Alice in Wonderland for children
 - Slumber Party for children (check navigator to confirm this)
 - Extra Daily Navigators for scrapbooking etc
- Children's Clubs, Deck 5 Mid Ship Sign up for the kids clubs, be issued with pagers and Mickey bands, as well as touring the facilities.
- Vista Spa, Deck 9 Forward Here you can book any spa treatments you have not been able to do online as well as touring the facilities. There will also be a list of spa talks and classes available so you can see what is going on while onboard.
- **Food Options** Options for lunch when you board are usually Parrot Cay for a buffet lunch, Topsiders for the same buffet lunch or one of the fast food locations on deck 9.
- In Your Stateroom Once you reach your stateroom we recommend that you:
 - Ask your stateroom host (housekeeping) to supply ice and also extra navigators each day if required. You will also need to confirm your planned sleeping arrangements such as bedrails, cribs etc and ask if you need extra hangers.
 - Make sure you check any rented tuxedos as soon as possible in case of required alterations
 - Send clothing out to be pressed early if you require it for formal nights
 - Hang out your fish extender as soon as possible as well as putting out any message boards
- Room Changes Make sure to pop to Sue's room (su_kraft) to write a note with any room changes on the first day. This will ensure any activities you've signed up for will run smoothly.

3. GENERAL CRUISE INFORMATION

- **Key to the World Card** This is your room key but also has a few extras on it you should know about it. On the bottom of the card will be a series of letters that refer to your dining rotation i.e. APTAPTAPTAP etc. This card will also act as a way for you to get on and off the cruise ship so don't forget it when you are going ashore. Finally, this is your currency for the cruise. Everything purchased onboard will use this card, except for Laundry detergent which requires \$1 bills, and tips which you can either pay in cash or charge to your room.
- Orientation While onboard, a good tip is that Aft is for things you Ate and is where most food locations are located, and Forward is for Fun which is where most of the entertainment areas are. Also if you look at the carpets around staterooms, red points Aft and blue points Forward on most floors. If in doubt, stateroom numbers go up as you move towards the back of the ship, with the first digit relating to deck number and the second digit equalling 0 or 1 for Port side of the ship and 5 or 6 for Starboard side.
- **Dining** Whether wanting a quick snack or a 4 course meal there are various dining treats to savour. Times vary for each dining location so its good to check the Navigator each day to confirm offerings:
 - o **Drinks** Soft drinks are free with all meals but are not free from bars or room service. There is a drinks station on Deck 9 aft near the Mickey Pool. You can carry drinks between venues and even take your own drinks in with you.
 - o **Breakfast** Lumiere's (Sit down), Goofy's Gallery (Snack), Cove Café (Snack), Topsiders (Buffet) and on selected days Parrot Cay (Buffet)
 - o **Brunch** Palo for \$15 per person or sometimes offered for free at Parrot Cay.
 - Lunch Lumiere's (Sit down), Goofy's Gallery (Snack), Pinocchios Pizzeria or Plutos Dog House (Snack), Cove Café (Snack) and Topsiders (Buffet)
 - Afternoon Tea Palo for \$5 per person and is only available for adults
 - Dinner Every night you are assigned one of the 3 rotational restaurants. Depending on rotation its either Lumiere's, Animators Palate or Parrot Cay (Sit down), Palo for \$15 per person, Topsiders (Sit down), Promenade Lounge (Snack), Diversions (Snack), Plutos Dog House or Pinocchio's Pizzeria (Snack)
 - Evening Snack Midnight buffet station in Beat Street and Promenade Lounge. On a selected night a Dessert Buffet is put on in Lumiere's and on Pirate Night there is a Snack Buffet on Deck 9 around the Goofy Pool.
- **Animator's Palate (Deck 4 Aft)** Rotational restaurant
 - o Innovative transforming restaurant that during one rotational meal on the cruise will change colour before your eyes.
- Lumiere's (Deck 3 Midship) Rotational restaurant
 - Themed around Beauty & the Beast this elegant restaurant is the most formal of the 3 rotational restaurants.
- Parrot Cay (Deck 3 Aft) Rotational restaurant
 - Island-themed restaurant with a tropical feel. Buffet's in here include drinks service at the table.

Other options include:

- Palo (Deck 10 Aft) Adult only restaurant Additional charges apply & a dress code
- Topsiders (Deck 9 Aft) Buffet restaurant during the day sit-down at night
- Pluto's Dog House (Deck 9 Midship) Burgers & Fries
- Pinocchio's Pizzeria (Deck 9 Midship) Pizza
- Goofy's Gallery (Deck 9 Aft) Sandwiches, Salads, Yoghurts & Ice-Cream

- **Dress Code** Each evening of the cruise the dress code for that night will be shown in the daily Navigator. For breakfast and lunch, restaurants adopt a Cruise Casual policy. The type of dress is explained below:
 - Cruise Casual shorts, swimwear or tank tops are not permitted in the dining rooms but jeans, khakis and capris are permitted
 - o Pirate Night cruise casual or pirate outfits can be worn in the dining rooms
 - **Semi-Formal** for men this is a suit or jacket with smart trousers, for women this is a dress or pantsuit
 - Formal for men this is a suit or tuxedo, for women this is a gown or dress
 - Palo Brunch / Afternoon Tea cruise casual is requested but no shorts, swimwear, tank tops or blue jeans are permitted
 - **Palo Dinner** for men this is a dress shirt or jacket and smart pants, for women this is a dress or pantsuit. Again no shorts, swimwear, tank tops or blue jeans are permitted
- Room Service Menu This can be found in the Information book in your stateroom and should be checked in case of updates or additional food items. Room service can be ordered 24 hours a day and is free but a small tip is recommended for each delivery.

Breakfast Menu (Ordered on door-hanger in room at 7, 7:30, 8, 8:30, 9, 9:30 or 10am)

- o Juices Orange, Apple or Grapefruit
- Breads & Pastries Danish Pastries, Fruit & bran muffin, Croissants, Doughnuts, Toast (White or Wholemeal), English muffin or Bagel
- Cold Cereals Corn flakes, Raisin bran, Rice Krispies, Fruit loops, KO's, Frosted flakes or Granola with Whole or Skim milk
- Beverages & Condiments Whole, Skim or Chocolate milk, Regular or Decaf coffee or Assortment of teas, selection of Jams, Butter and or Honey

All Day Menu (Ordered via phone in Stateroom)

- Salads & Appetizers Southwestern Caesar salad, Chicken quesadilla salad, Mexican tortilla soup, Chicken noodle soup, Cheese platter or Fresh fruit bowl
- Sandwiches BLT, Steak, Ham/Turkey & cheese, Focaccia with zucchini, mushrooms & aioli,
 Tuna salad or Chicken fajita wrap
- o All American Fayre Cheeseburger, Hot dog or Macaroni & Cheese
- Chef Specials Mexican fiesta pizza, Vegetarian pizza, Pepperoni pizza or Meat or Vegetable lasagna
- o Dessert Cake of the day, Big island cookie or Oatmeal raisin cookie
- Free Items Not On Menu But Sometimes Available Mickey Ice Cream Bars, Mickey Rice Crispy Treats, Peanut Butter & Jelly Uncrustables or Fries
- **Shopping** While not in port, shops on the ship will be open for purchases, using your Key To The World card. Mickey's Mates is for younger cruisers and Disney pin collectors while Treasure Ketch has more adult merchandise. Both are found on Deck 4 Forward. Also Duty Free shopping for alcohol and cigarettes is available from Upbeat on Deck 3 Forward. Specials are offered on various days throughout the cruise.
- Internet Internet café's are located in Cove Café on Deck 9 Forward (adult only) and the Promenade Lounge on Deck 3 Midship. There is a charge for using the internet per minute but packages can be purchased for set numbers of minutes. A wireless package is also available for those with wireless devises. The prices of packages are:
 - o \$0.75 for 1 minute
 - \$55 for 100 minutes
 - o \$100 for 250 minutes
 - o \$150 for 500 minutes

- Shutters (Deck 4 Midship) While onboard Disney photographers will take various photos of you and your family. They can be purchased from Shutters individually, as a photo package (see Shutters for prices), or as a CD of all photos on your cruise for \$399. You can also get memory cards transferred overnight on to CD's for a fee.
- Laundry There are 3 laundry rooms onboard and a wash or dry cycle costs around \$2.00. These are charged via your key to the world room card. There is also an iron and ironing board that are free to use. They are located:
 - o **Deck 2** across from stateroom 2096
 - o **Deck 6** across from stateroom 6588
 - o **Deck 7** across from stateroom 7590
- **Dry Cleaning & Pressing** Clothes can be sent out for dry cleaning or pressing by using the bags within your closet and is returned the next day. Pressing is half the price of dry cleaning and an up to date list of prices can be found in your closet.
- Medical Centre (Deck 1 Forward) Although no one wants to think about getting ill while on vacation, just in case anything happens its good to know the location. Also note that sea sickness medication is available free of charge in self service bucket at the centre. If the Medical Centre is closed, ask at Guest Services on Deck 3 Midship for help.
- Autographs Characters can often be found in the Atrium (Deck 3 Midship) as well as wandering
 around the ship. If you want to get a specific item autographed by all characters onboard you can ask at
 Guest Services (Deck 3 Midship) but this should be handed in early on the cruise to avoid
 disappointment. During the cruise you will also get an opportunity to get items signed by the Captain
 and by Donald "Ducky" Williams but these will be advertised in the daily navigator.
- Pools There are 3 main pools as well as 4 hot tubs.
 - Mickey Pool (Deck 9 Aft)

 This pool is aimed at younger children and found forward on the ship. There is also a splash area under Mickey's hand for toddlers that are still in diapers. The Mickey slide has a height restriction of 38 to 64 inches and an age restriction of 4 to 14.
 - Goofy Pool (Deck 9 Midship)

 This is for families and has 2 large hot tubs so adults can relax
 while keeping an eye on the kids. The pool is Covered over for most deck parties and they also
 show movies on the large screen over the pool.
 - Quiet Cove Pool (Deck 9 Forward) This is exclusively for adults aged 18 and over and also has 2 hot tubs available.
- Adult Entertainment Most of the adult entertainment occurs in Beat Street on Deck 3 forward. There are also culinary demonstrations and tasting sessions that may incur a charge. Some of the more adult orientated locations are listed below:
 - Promenade Lounge (Deck 3 Midship) This quieter lounge has snacks in at night from around 5pm till about 7pm and may also have musicians performing
 - Cove Café (Deck 9 Midship) A coffee bar exclusively for adults.
 - Diversions (Beat Street, Deck 3 Forward) This bar is a sports themed bar. It contains lots of games and also has snacks between 5pm & 7pm some nights.
 - Outlook Bar (Deck 10 Forward) This bar is rarely open.
 - Rockin Bar D (Beat Street, Deck 3 Forward) This is where most of the events for adults take place. Every night after any activities this turns into a lively dance club or even a karaoke bar. Check daily Navigator for activities.
 - Sessions (Beat Street, Deck 3 Forward) A laid back piano bar
 - Signals (Quiet Cove Pool, Deck 9 Forward) Great pool bar for adults only
 - Vista Spa & Salon (Deck 9 Forward) This adult only spa is a great place to relax and be pampered. It is also the location of the Gym onboard.

- Family Entertainment A lot of the family activities take place on Deck 4 of the ship. Some activities also take place on Deck 9, where the Goofy Pool is often covered over to allow activities to take place right on top of it.
 - Studio Sea (Deck 4 Midship) This is where most of the family evening events take place and the culinary demonstrations
 - Walt Disney Theatre (Deck 4 Forward) Every night this theatre plays host to a show or act to tantalise you. Showings are usually at 6pm and repeated at 8pm but check your navigator for times.
 - Buena Vista Theatre (Deck 5 Aft) This movie theatre will show various movies throughout the cruise. Keep an eye on your daily Navigator for times and listings.
- **Kids Activities** Onboard there are different levels of kids clubs available providing various kids activities based on the age of the child. This being said, children in the Oceaneer's Club & Lab are able to attend activities in either area but age recommendations are given for activities in the daily navigators. Below are some of the things available:
 - Flounder's Reef (Deck 5 Aft) Available for infants aged 12 weeks to 3 years. This is charged at \$6 per hour for a minimum of 2 hours at a time. This must be reserved in advance. Only 4 infants and 16 toddlers are allowed in the area at 1 time and parents receive a pager in case of an emergency.
 - Oceaneer's Club (Deck 5 Midship) Recommended for children aged 3 to 7. Activities are split between 2 age categories (3-4 & 5-7) and are all free. Parents check children in at the desk and again receive a pager. At Castaway Cay Scuttle's Cove is specially designed for kids to go to instead of the Oceaneer's Club. Activities are scheduled in the Navigator each day.
 - Oceaneer's Lab (Deck 5 Midship) Recommended for children aged 8 to 10. Children can check themselves in and out if parents have given them permission to do so. Activities are scheduled in the Navigator each day.
 - Ocean Quest (Deck 2 Midship) Available for tweens (age 11 to 13) this place is great if you love video games and having fun!
 - The Stack (Deck 11 Midship) Available for teens aged 13 to 17. This coffee shop like area is
 exclusive for teenagers and allows freedom for them to express themselves. Activities are still
 scheduled in the Navigator each day.
 - Quarter Masters (Deck 9 Midship) Here kids can play in an arcade on the seas. Note this
 does incur extra costs.
 - Wide World of Sports Deck (Deck 10 Forward) This area is dedicated to sports. From Basketball to Soccer you'll find a range of activities available.
- **Tips** On the last night of the cruise envelopes for tips for your Stateroom Host and Dining Team will be placed in your room for you to complete. You can either put cash in the envelopes or charge the tips to your Stateroom (which can actually be done at any point during the cruise). Other types of tips and recommended tips are shown below:
 - o **Dining Room Server –** \$56 per person per stateroom
 - Dining Room Assistant Server \$42 per person per stateroom
 - Dining Room Head Server \$14 per person per stateroom
 - Stateroom Host \$56 per person per stateroom
 - o Room Service Discretionary but usually \$1 per person per order
 - o **Palo** 15% gratuity included
 - o **Bar Drinks** 15% gratuity included
 - Vista Spa Discretionary
 - Nursery & Children's Programming Optional and not expected

4. GENERAL PORT ADVICE

- Accessibility The ship moors alongside the dock. Wheelchair travellers can access the shore side via the ships gangway. The slope changes based on tide conditions and ships crew is available to assist guest where needed.
- **Clothing** Any tours entering churches or cathedrals in Europe will require women to Cove their shoulders and legs. It is best to take a cardigan just in case.
- Safety Some useful tips are:
 - Don't forget to carry your Key To The World room key as well as photo ID with you when getting off the ship.
 - Do not carry large amounts of cash with you or show money in public.
 - o Take off the ship only what you need remembering your key to the world card at all times.
 - Leave tickets and cruise documentation in your stateroom, as you will not require this onshore.
 - Take the name and contact information for your ship's agent at the port (which is noted in the Navigators daily) as you will need this number if you have any problems while off the ship.
 - Be vigilant in crowded places such as metro station, open air terraces and lines to enter museums as these can be attractive to pick pockets.
 - Be diligent washing your hands with the sanitary wipes and gel as you get on and off the ship to help ensure that you don't get ill onboard (and remember to use them when you go to any restaurants onboard as well).

- Currency The Euro & most places accept credit cards for payments over 10 Euros
- **Getting Around** Cabs are black and yellow in markings. If the green light on top is on then the taxi is empty and available. Many do flat rate trips but it is advisable to use metered cabs instead. Most taxis only accept cash payment.
- **Safety in Barcelona** Barcelona has some of the lowest crime rates in Europe but be careful to protect valuables.
- Places of Interest Las Rambles (shopping), La Sagrada Familia (Gaudi Church to be completed by 2026), L'Aquarium (wildlife), Montserrat Mountain (Benedictine Abbey), Museu Picasso (Museum), Magic Fountain of Montjuic (at 8pm nightly)
- Port Address Port de Barcelona (Port Vell), Moll D'Adossat Terminal D, Barcelona, Spain 08039
- Embarkation Should begin around 10:30am to 11am and all guest should be onboard by 3pm
- Average Temperature High 78 Low 63

6. GIBRALTAR UNITED KINGDOM

- Language English or Spanish
- Useful phrases See Barcelona information for useful Spanish phrases
- **Currency** Pound Sterling is the official currency although Euros are widely accepted. All major credit cards are accepted for payments over 10 pound or Euro.
- **Tipping** Tipping is used to show good service and will not be automatically added to bills. 5% is customary.
- **Shopping** Most shops open between 10am and 6pm. There is no sales tax and this makes it good value for wine, spirits, perfume, leather goods, linens, electronics & cameras. Many British retailers such as Marks & Spencers, BHS and Top Shop have locations.
- **Getting Around** The terminal is 330 feet from the ship and contains telephones, a coffee shop and a taxi stand. Downtown Gibraltar is around 15 minutes by foot (1/2 a mile) and shuttles are available for around 2 Euros per person from the terminal. A cable car runs from the town centre up to 2 different locations on the rock.
- Safety in Gibraltar Guests should be aware that the Barbary Macaques Monkeys appear playful but are known to bite and run off with valuables. Watch anything shiny and do not feed as a fine of 500 Euros may occur.
- Places of Interest The top of the Rock (great views of the ship), Apes Den (see the Barbary Monkeys), St Michael's Cave (Concert hall in the rock), Great Siege Tunnel (30 miles of tunnels from World War II), Gibraltar Museum, Europa Point (view of 2 continents Europe & Africa)
- Average Temperatures High 79 Love 67

- Language Portuguese is the official language although many people speak English

- **Currency** Euro is the official currency and all major credit cards are accepted in most stores, although a minimum payment may apply.
- **Tipping** Tipping is customary. In restaurants the amount is from 5% to 10% unless a service charge is included. Some eateries will include a standard service charge. For taxi drivers a 10% tip is suggested.
- **Getting Around** Taxis operating within Funchal, the capital, are metered. Those outside work on a mileage basis and do not use the meter. The government sets prices for predefined taxi routes, which will be listed, on the back of the drivers seat in all cabs.
- Safety in Madeira Funchal is a resort destination considered very safe.
- Places of Interest Lido Promenade (great restaurants along the seafront), Madeira Story Centre (Museum), Madeira Wine Museum, Monte Palace Tropical Gardens (18th century gardens), Sao Vicente's Volcanic Caves (from an eruption 400,000 years ago), Funchal Cable Car, Toboggan ride down from the Funchal Cable Care
- Average Temperatures High 75 Low 67

- Language Dutch and French are the official languages but English is widely spoken

- **Currency** US Dollars are accepted in most places on the Dutch side although prices may be shown in Florins(NAF). On the French side of the island Euros are the main currency. All major credit cards are accepted in most stores.
- **Getting Around** Rental cars are easy to access in St Maarten. Traffic issue such as jams are frequent between Marigot and Phillipsburg (the 2 capital cities). Taxis are usually in the form of a van and are found at the dockside. A complete island tour costs around 25 Dollars in a taxi. Also there is a bus system that is very cost effective but tends to be a little slower than other methods.
- Safety in St Maarten St Maarten is a resort destination considered very safe.
- Places of Interest Fort St. Louis (1767 King Louis XVI fort with panoramic views), Mount Concordia (where the original treaty was signed giving dual ownership of land), Marigot (French capital), Phillipsburg (Dutch capital), Orient Beach
- Average Temperatures High 88 Low 72

9 TORTOLA BRITISH VIRGIN ISLANDS

- **Getting Around** A short walk from the dock will take you to the tram station. Here you can catch a tram around to the Family Beach on Castaway Cay. You can also choose to walk to the beach via the relevant pathway, taking around 15 minutes. To get to the Adult only Serenity Bay you can choose to either catch a different tram or walk the 20 minute distance.
- Safety in Castaway Cay As the Island is a private island the island is considered safe. Be careful of wildlife however.


